PRESENTERS/BREAK-OUT SESSIONS

"Fueling up to Rotate" Presenter: Sherry Wilberscheid, Gloria Dei, New Holstein & Resource Center Volunteer will have you discussing reasons for using rotations, how to schedule classes, ways to share information with your council and congregation, sample job descriptions, and any questions you may have about getting "started" or "restarted" with Rotation Sunday School.

**"Designing the Engine for Rotation" Pre-
 senter: Sherry Wilberscheid,** Gloria Dei, New Holstein & Resource Center Volunteer will introduce you to, and will have you practice using, a simple format for designing a well planned lesson that can be used for any age level. Resource materials and sample lessons will be available for you to peruse.

"Firelight II and Beyond" Presenter: Lori Nicol, is an Augsburg Fortress Field Sales Representative who will discuss the current curriculum and present thoughts and ideas for the future.

**"Group Building in Your Sunday School Class-
 room" Presenter: erika page,** Camp Director at Crossways, Pine Lake Camp. Your Sunday School Class is together for one hour a week . . . if you're lucky. If you want the children to feel comfortable, learn, and enjoy their church experience, then your class needs bonding. Learn activities that will help you instill cooperation and trust in your group.

**"Stone Soup, Enough to Feed Your Congrega-
 tion" Presenter: Ruth Melzer,** Our Savior's, Neenah. Decoration on a shoe string budget isn't impossible, you just need to be creative with what you have and gather a few more resources. She has some great ideas for you!!!

**"Rev-ing up the Rotation!" Presenter: Alli-
 son Thome,** Shepherd of the Hills, Greenville. Don't be a one man pit crew. Find creative ways to recruit reluctant volunteers and charge up the congregation. Allison, past rotation coordinator, overworked music educator and mother of adolescent boys, will lead this session on being one step ahead of the game. Allison will share ideas that she has used to market the rotation program and welcomes you to bring ideas to share. Part of this session will focus on developing a marketing idea that you may take with you.

**"Experiencing God in Sunday School" Pastor
 Catherine Mode,** Pastor of Our Savior's Lutheran Church, Neenah The goal of Christian Education is not simply knowledge of Jesus, but rather coming to know Jesus, experiencing God and growing in Faith. Some of our best efforts in Sunday School can actually get in the way of faith development. Pastor Mode will help participants focus more on "learning" and less on "teaching".
